

The <u>NOAA Climate and Fisheries Adaptation (CAFA) Program</u> is now accepting full proposals for the <u>FY23 Funding Opportunity</u>. The deadline for submitting a proposal is November 21st, 2022 by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time. The CAFA Program is soliciting proposals to address either of two research topics:

- **Type A Proposals:** Advancing multidisciplinary systems to evaluate strategies that promote resilience and adaptation of fish stocks, fisheries, and fishing communities.
- **Type B Proposals:** Enhancing the effectiveness of locally determined adaptation planning in frontline fishing communities.

Full proposals must be submitted via <u>grants.gov</u> or received by mail by **5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on November 21st, 2022**.
